

Requirements: Stay on-track to graduate in four years with a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA, mentor a child at least 5 hours per month, attend monthly program meetings, meet with mentor monthly

Pay It Forward Scholarship & Mentoring Program Timeline for Class Entering Fall 2023

Confirm your student is eligible. They must be a first-generation college student who meets the A-G Requirements for CSUMB and be a US Citizen or Permanent Resident residing in Monterey County for at least the past 5 years.

Nominate your eligible student. Complete our <u>online form</u> and submit it during the nomination period from 10/7/22 to 12/09/22.

Encourage your student to apply. We will email your eligible student the link to our online application form and you will be copied on the message. They must submit their form during the application period from 1/13/23 to 2/17/23.

Prepare your student for their interview. Selected students will schedule an interview with our Scholarship Selection Committee and you will be copied on the email invite. Interviews are scheduled to take place from 4/3/23 to 4/6/23.
