The After-School Teacher is responsible for education and care of participants enrolled in the program. Duties include developing a comprehensive curriculum, planning daily activities, and assisting students with assignments. The Taylor Farms Center for Learning provides a powerful curriculum of academic programs, educational support, and continuous life skills training. The continuum touches each part of their life from elementary school to college in three primary focus areas: Academia, STEAM, and Life Exploration and Preparation.

## **Duties and Responsibilities**

Under the direct supervision of the Program Director and Program Coordinator:

- Promote First Tee's mission by modeling The First Tee Nine Core Values and adherence to The First Tee Code of Conduct.
- Interact with parents, participants and other staff members to create a safe and fun learning environment for children.
- Develop curriculum that align with Center for Learning's focus on STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Mathematics), Academia, and Life Exploration and Preparation.
- Prepare all material needed for lesson or activity.
- Assist participants with their homework.
- Encourage social, physical, and intellectual growth.
- Interact with participants to provide guidance, emotional support, and guidance.
- Meet with parents to discuss their children's performance and any areas in need of improvement.
- Maintain an organized and clean classroom environment and ensure participants conduct themselves appropriately.
- Ensure that all rules and guidelines in the Center for Learning are adhered to by participants.
- Oversee activities in the Center for Learning.

• Perform duties out of class, as assigned.
